Youth Ministry

It usually happens quietly, without fanfare. Sometimes the very people involved, don't even realize they are doing it. It's critical that it happens not only in our small, personal circles, but for the well-being of the world at large. It can be a formal process with training and workshops and forms, but in the ideal, it happens more naturally — it happens with a connection as simple as a smile and, "How is your day?" It's a connection between grown-up and kids, it's mentoring, it's intentionally communicating care to the next generation. Bill Crawford did it last month when he visited the Senior High Bible study and share his life story with pictures and life mantras and his trumpet. Dozens of teens will do it this summer at VBS, holding hands and guiding little ones from station to station. Crowds of mentors came together on Confirmation Sunday — parents, grandparents, baptismal sponsors, friends, faith family members. When mentoring happens, "...high school dropout rates fall, college completion rates rise, economic mobility increases, and ultimately, the economy is stronger from an increase in productive workers." (*The Mentoring Effect*) What more can be impacted when we integrate our faith into the mentoring process? What can happen when we come alongside individuals and families and lend our gifts, our encouragement and our time to mentor their journey? In Deuteronomy 6 we read, "*Write these commandments that I've given you today on your hearts. Get them inside of you and then get them inside your children. Talk about them wherever you are, sitting at home or walking in the street; talk about them from the time you get up in the morning to when you fall into bed at night. Tie them on your hands and foreheads as a reminder; inscribe them on the doorposts of your homes and on your city gates.*" I'm starting the conversation in earnest — what can you do to bring up the next generation in faith?

SHINE

We have spent a good deal of time in SWAT this semester talking about the verse in Matthew that calls us to "let our light shine before others." We've talked about how we can shine God's light, not only with our words, but with our deeds so that others might be able to see God's love through the things we say and do. I would ask you to take some time this summer to see how you can shine. How can your words and actions help show God's love? The flip side of that is looking for ways God shines for us each day. How does he show us His love? Finding those little evidences of God in our everyday life is something we call God Sightings. We will talk about God Sightings in VBS, and I encourage you to look for them with your children. Sometimes it's as simple as a smile from a stranger when you're having a bad day. But, once you start to notice the little evidences of God in your life, it becomes so much easier to shine his love to others.




Concert following game featuring Brandon Heath
