



# Pastor's Paragraphs

In the Gospel according to St. John, Jesus breathed on the disciples and said receive the Holy Spirit. What a way to highlight the message of the resurrection! The Body of Christ rejoices that the resurrection proclamation continues because of the ongoing work of God the Holy Spirit. The 40 days of Lenten discipline are replaced with the 40 days of Easter celebration, culminating in the Ascension and the Feast of Pentecost. The wonder of the gift of everlasting life is brought to us by faith that is initiated and sustained by the Comforter, the third Person of the Trinity, the One Jesus promised. We cannot come to faith in the resurrected Lord on our own. This is the work of the Holy Spirit. Thanks be to God that while we were dead in our trespasses and sins, he bought us to life and continues to sustain us to life everlasting!

The Feast of Pentecost, the marking of fifty days, began as a Jewish festival recounting the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. For us as Christians, it marks the dramatic birth of the Church. The Holy Spirit came upon the first disciples with power and wonder, attracting great crowds. Now the disciples were emboldened to engage the mission of making other disciples of all nations...Parthians, Medes, Elamites, *et al.* Now the Good News of Jesus crucified and resurrected was for the nations! It is God the Holy Spirit that empowers each of us to be witnesses (derived from the Greek word for martyr!) in word and deed. That witnessing is foundational to our Rite of Confirmation, celebrated on Pentecost Sunday. Our instructed and prepared young people (some twenty-two this year) witness their faith and declare that they will be witnesses, even unto martyrdom. Baptismal faith is confirmed. We rejoice with all of them as they take the next step in their faith-life journey.

Congratulations to all of our graduating high school Seniors! Now for the next steps...

The report from the Hope finance folks as they tally the weekly receipts is not very encouraging. Receipts are soft, as they say. That report impacts the way we carry out mission activities...from Texas District support, to educational workshops and programs, to Staff initiatives, to optimism about tomorrow. Consequently, I urge you to reevaluate your financial commitment to this congregation. The good steward realizes that he but manages what belongs to Someone else. The commitment to percentage, first-fruits and cheerful giving of dollars is the mark of one who understands how God's economy works, even when our petroleum underpinnings seem so shaky. I invite you to join me in this God-pleasing effort to sustain our mission with our gifts!

## CONFIRMATION

Later this month, our Confirmands will conclude their three-year studies of the Scriptures and Christian doctrine. On Saturday, May 14th we will celebrate Faith Builders VI. That evening, the parents of our Confirmation Candidates will have the opportunity to bless their child and present him or her to the Church saying: "My child is prepared to be confirmed in the Faith." Then, our candidates will publicly confess, in their own words, the Faith we all share in Jesus Christ. The candidates are working hard on their statements and we look forward to hearing them. The next day — May 15th — we will celebrate Confirmation Sunday during the Festival of Pentecost. At our 11:00 a.m. service, the candidates will publicly confess the Faith and will declare their intent to continue in the Faith — affirming their baptism. And then what? Their journey of faith in the Faith continues! Please continue to pray for and encourage all our young people in the Confirmation program as they study and prepare to confess the Faith — the Faith into which we have been baptized.

How are your conversations going? Have you talked with anyone before or after worship that you don't know? People are coming to visit Hope. So keep on developing conversations and relationships with someone new who has come seeking the wisdom and knowledge of God. Help them find the wisdom and knowledge of God in the foolishness of the cross of Jesus Christ and in the exclamation from the empty tomb, "Christ is Risen!"

## OUTREACH

This project is still in development. However, I would like to launch it sometime in August — before school and extracurricular schedules get going and dominate people's lives. What do you think? I would love to hear from you what you think, what might work, and how you may want to get involved.



A little bit of Lutheran Women's Missionary League history for our Texas Gulf Coast Zone was made when the Spring Rally was hosted by our Ladies Guild. More than 40 women from eight area LWML's met on April 17th to "Serve the Lord with Gladness."

In recognition of LWML's 75th anniversary in 2017, it was voted to designate the day's offering to the National Endowment Fund. It is from this fund that women are awarded scholarships for Lutheran faith based careers.

The day's theme, Faith Talk, featured many topics useful to not only faith talk, but faith walk, such as stories from the heart, faith experience, personal prayer, faith sharing opportunities in encounters, crisis and relationships. We are the Church, and after worshiping we leave to enter the Mission Field.

A review of the Zones Societies donations to Lutheran World Relief this Spring include: 268 Quilts, 95 School Kits, 108 Personal Care Kits, 36 Baby Kits, 164 pounds of soap, \$369.80 for shipping costs. It is our joy to provide in our small way for world-wide needs for those we will not meet this side of eternity. We are all God's children.

## Treasurer's Report

### Fiscal Year 2016

Fiscal Year (FY) 2016 closed with an operating loss of \$6,087. Receipts were \$947,855 and expenses were \$953,943. The loss is likely a result of our current economy, and as mentioned at the recent Voters' Assembly, was considered in our future planning for FY 2017.

The Building Fund began FY 2016 with an outstanding debt of \$1,471,465. Because of your contributions and investments, we were able to make additional principal payments of \$117,510. The outstanding debt at the close of FY 2016 was \$1,316,769.

Please keep in mind, when planning your contribution for FY 2017, that we operate on a cash basis, and need your support to carry out Hope's mission. We thank you for your faithful giving to Hope Lutheran Church — for what it means for our congregation and for God's mission to the world.
